## **IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT - SCHOOL OPEN MONDAY 23 NOVEMBER 2020**

Premier, Stephen Marshall announced today that all schools and preschools in South Australia will reopen to students on Monday 23 November 2020.

**In response to this announcement, I am writing to confirm that Torrens Valley Christian School will be open to provide face-to-face lessons for all students as normal, as from Monday 23 November.**

OSHC will operate as usual.

## **IMPORTANT REMINDERS**

The Chief Public Health Officer, Professor Nicola Spurrier has reminded us that we must not become complacent. Risks associated with COVID-19 have not passed.

We appreciate therefore your support and understanding in observing these important reminders and helping us ensure the wellbeing of our community as we work together.

- The number of people coming and going from our site will be minimised.
- Please drop and collect your child at the gate and maintain the appropriate physical distance from other adults.
- As a school, we remain vigilant in the sanitising process being applied to all classrooms and workspaces and to implementing the four-square meter social distancing guidelines.
- If you, or any of your students, have any symptoms of COVID-19, even mild (fever, chills, sore throat, cough, runny nose, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell), stay at home, and get tested for COVID-19. Students presenting with symptoms are advised to self-isolate until given the medical clearance to return to school.
- We are monitoring the updates from the Premier carefully and the TVCS Leadership are meeting daily to review and plan accordingly. As more information comes to hand we will be able to make decisions on future excursions, events, sporting activities, and use of masks
