General Position Description

The Music Teacher is responsible for the delivery of the School's music program from Years 2-7 and takes responsibility for planning, implementing, assessing and reporting against educational programs in line with the Australian Curriculum and the aims, values and ethos of the school.

Key Responsibilities and Accountabilities

The successful applicant will:

- » Be part of an R-12 Performing Arts faculty, with teaching duties mostly in Primary and Middle School specialist classroom music
- » Provide a contemporary, relevant and student-centred education
- » Be an active musician with qualifications majoring in Music Education
- » Have knowledge of Kodaly, Orff and Dalcroze approaches to Music education and the ability to implement these into a sequential teaching program
- » Be willing to support the Instrumental and Ensemble programs within the Performing Arts Faculty, with the ability to direct and assist with vocal and / or instrumental ensembles as required
- » Organise excursions as required including bookings, consent documentation and communication with parents and other staff
- » Work as a team member with the other music staff to coordinate and facilitate the whole R-12 Programme in events such as Music Night, Carols and night-time Graduations
- » Attend Performing Arts faculty meetings as required
- » Take yard duties as rostered and attend staff meetings
- » Registration with SA Teachers' Registration Board
